Wrap-around Support for Pregnant Women and New Mothers Who Use Substances

Friday, November 26, 2021, 12 – 1:15 p.m.

This presentation will describe promising approaches offered by community based, wraparound support services, reaching pregnant women and new mothers who use substances and their children. Dr Deborah Rutman will share key approaches offered by eight communitybased services located across Canada, evidenced in the Co-Creating Evidence study. Hayley Thomas will offer practice wisdom based on her experience as a service provider with Manito Iklwe Kagiikwe - Mothering Project in Winnipeg. Dr Nancy Poole will add ideas about collaboration with child welfare and how policy values can guide our work, from the Mothering and Opioids toolkit. It is hoped that service providers in both rural and urban locations will be inspired by the practice ideas covered, and be keen to engage in discussion of these approaches and how they fit for their work.
