This primary research is a Masters Thesis in Community Health Science completed in 2018 with a journal publication accepted for 2021. It explores parents' experiences of managing FASD within the family context, family cohesion, psychological warfare, and experiences of supports. Findings suggest a multi-sector, multi-disciplinary, tailored, family centred approach to care across the lifespan as required to support family's efforts in maintain equilibrium.

Lisa is a parent of a child with FASD, an educator, a nature enthusiast, a goat farmer, and a passionate advocate for family well-being.
