Targeted violence and systemic oppression have resulted in the disproportionate representation of Indigenous peoples in service delivery areas such as justice, child welfare, health, and so on. Similarly, we are aware of the connections and risks associated with FASD as it relates to involvement in those systems. The challenges and barriers that people living with FASD experience, can make them more easily targeted for violence, for example, MMIWG2S. This gives cause to explore the ways in which individuals, service providers and systems can act as FASD allies in this context. 'Moral Courage for Mobilizing Justice' will explore our personal, collective and systemic journeys for justice and reconciliation.
